Workshop Format:

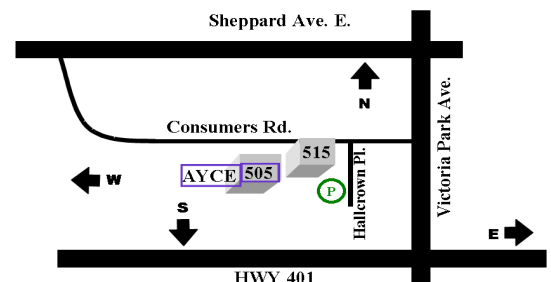
- Approximately 3 hours long
