



## **WORKPLACE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INFORMATION SYSTEM (WHMIS)**

### **WHAT IS WHMIS TRAINING?**

The basic Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) is a nationwide system to provide information on hazardous materials used in the workplace. This WHMIS instruction program is designed to be delivered in a 6 hour period and is broken down into 9 specific modules as follows;

- ❖ Module 1 – Introduction to WHMIS
- ❖ Module 2 – Legislation
- ❖ Module 3 – Occupational
- ❖ Module 4 – Classification and Symbols
- ❖ Module 5 - Labelling
- ❖ Module 6 - MSDS
- ❖ Modules 7 – Information and Training
- ❖ Module 8 – Controlling Hazards
- ❖ Module 9 – Optional for technical areas & WHMIS Laboratories
- ❖ Summary DVD
- ❖ Quiz and Evaluation

### **WHO SHOULD TAKE WHMIS TRAINING?**

This is a one day basic certification for all employees working in various sectors. WHMIS recognizes the interests of workers, employer, supplier's and regulator's balancing the workers right to know with industry's right to protect confidential business information.
